

1.2. Research Nurse

Purpose of the role

The Research Nurse performs delegated operational and supporting tasks in the execution of clinical research, including authorized medical procedures.

Reporting lines

The functional reporting line is to the Coordinating Investigator. The Research Nurse reports to the Research Pool Coordinator

Key tasks

- To maintain communications with different disciplines in the intramural and extramural healthcare environment in relation to the clinical research
- To read and assess the research protocol for subject stress
- Assist in the planning, preparation, running, evaluation and steering the study
- Provide care to the study subjects in a client oriented way, before, during and after the study
- Assists in the set up and implementation of Visit Schedules, checklists, flowcharts and procedures
- Screening of trial subjects for potential inclusion
- To participate with or perform autonomously all the tasks necessary for a subject visit
- Instruct the subject on medication administration and expected side effects or sensations
- To verify, identify and distribute or administer the trial products to the subject
- To autonomously inform the subjects on the study goals, timelines, conduct and advantages and disadvantages of the study
- Taking care of product accountability
- Setting up Standard Operation Procedures for delegated tasks
- To prepare, carry out, evaluate and adjust medical operations
- To assess study results for completeness and correctness
- Collect and enter study data in data entry system or CRF
- Administration of study documents
- Ensure the quality of the study results
